

EMERGENCY NURSE RESIDENCY PROGRAM



Program Description:

The Trinitas Emergency Nurse Residency Program is designed for the Registered Nurse who has an interest in experiencing the critical care environment of an Emergency Department. The program will enhance assessment and prioritization skills as well as support the transition of a novice/mid-level nurse into a skillful professional and confident nurse. This 16 week program will build on the foundation of nursing practice and commitment to the future of the nursing profession. It will increase confidence in assessment, decision-making, prioritization and critical thinking skills. Hands-on clinical experience will occur under the supervision of an experienced preceptor.

Requirements:

- Registered Nurse that have recently graduated or graduated within the last 12 months / a mid-level nurse transitioning into acute care
- Malpractice Insurance coverage of \$1 million to \$3 million per year
- American Heart Association BLS
- Satisfactorily pass a criminal background check and pre-residency physical exam, which includes a drug test
