

## TRINITAS SCHOOL OF NURSING

### **IMPORTANT INFORMATION REGARDING ELIGIBILITY FOR RE-ENTRY FOR NURE 131 AND ABOVE**

Students who have not maintained the published sequence of nursing (NURE) curriculum courses are required to seek re-entry into NURE courses. The break in sequence may be due to:

- Course withdrawal
- Course failure
- Students who have successfully passed a NURE course but have, for other reasons, chosen not to enroll into the next NURE course

**A minimum Union County College GPA of 2.5 is required to submit a re-entry application.**

**There is no guarantee of course re-entry after curriculum sequence has been interrupted.** Please note, students are required to complete their nursing program track within 6 semesters of the initial start of the first clinical NURE course (Generic track: NURE 131; LPN-RN track: NURE 211/212).

Available re-entry seats are offered in the following order:

- Out of sequence students, taking course for the first time, in GPA order
- Students applying after course withdrawal, in GPA order
- Students applying after course failure, in GPA order

**Students with two NURE course failures are ineligible for course re-entry.** However, students who have two nursing course failures **after completing the last course in their specified curriculum (NURE 232 or NURE 280/290)** may apply for Re-Admission. The Re-Admission procedure can be found in Trinitas School of Nursing's Student Handbook.

#### **Submission of completed Re-Entry Applications:**

A paper version of your application and current Union County College transcript are to be submitted at the School of Nursing's Main Office, RM. 324 of the Kellogg Building. **Applications are due December 21<sup>st</sup> (or date grades are posted) for the Spring Semester and June 1<sup>st</sup> for the Fall semester.**

Those that are invited will be notified via the student's Union County College Owl e-mail address. E-mail invitations **will not** be sent to a personal e-mail address, nor will an e-mail be sent if you do not include your Union County College e-mail address on your Re-Entry Application.

**Applicants who are granted re-entry are required to submit the results of a NEW drug screen and criminal background check.** All required health documents must be current for the re-entry semester requested.
