### **IMPORTANT INFORMATION REGARDING ELIGIBILITY FOR RE-ENTRY FOR NURE 131 AND ABOVE**

Re-Entry into a NURE course refers to those students who exit the Nursing program or have not maintained the sequence of NURE courses. Students requesting Re-Entry into NURE 131 and above must obtain and complete the Re-Entry Application.

Examples include students who:

1. Withdraw from an NURE course
2. Have only one NURE course failure\*
3. Successfully pass an NURE course and do not enter into the next NURE course.

**A minimum Union County College GPA of 2.75 is required to submit a re-entry application**

**There is no guarantee of Re-Entry into the Nursing Program.**

Re-Entry decisions are based upon GPA and a number of other factors including but not limited to:

- Number of seats available
- Number of previous course withdrawals
- Number of Clinical Warnings
- The presence and nature of any Critical Event reports
- Time out of the nursing sequence

#### **Submission of completed Re-Entry Applications:**

A paper version of your application and current Union County College transcript are to be submitted at the School of Nursing's Main Office, RM. 324 of the Kellogg Building. **Applications are due December 21<sup>st</sup> (or date grades are posted) for the Spring Semester and June 1<sup>st</sup> for the Fall semester.**

Those that are invited will be notified via the student's Union County College Owl e-mail address. E-mail invitations **will not** be sent to a personal e-mail address, nor will an e-mail be sent if you do not include your Union County College e-mail address on your Re-Entry Application. **The decision regarding a student's re-entry into the Nursing program is final**

*\*Students who have two nursing course failures **after completing the last course in their specified curriculum (NURE 232 or NURE 280/290)** may apply for Re-Admission. The Re-Admission procedure can be found in Trinitas School of Nursing's Student Handbook.*

#### **A note for students planning to re-enter NURE 130:**

If you wish to be considered for NURE 130 Re-Entry, please submit a NURE 130 Consideration for Enrollment form. Please note, NURE 130 re-entry applicants must follow the instructions and submission dates outlined on the NURE 130 Consideration for Enrollment form.
