Explanation of Application Requirements (by number)

1. Completion of the Union County College application and admission process

- a. All applicants to Trinitas School of Nursing must be current Union County College students, therefore completion of the Union County College application and admission process is required to apply to Trinitas School of Nursing.
- b. Visit www.ucc.edu/admissions/ for information regarding the UCC admission process

2. Completion of developmental course work

- a. If applicable, please review the developmental course work in English and Math required to be eligible for Trinitas School of Nursing with **Academic Advising**. The following courses must be successfully completed to be admitted to Trinitas.
 - MAT 017 and ENG 097
- b. This requirement is **not applicable** to students who have met the passing standard on Union County College placement testing and have been placed into college level courses.
- c. Students with questions regarding whether they are required to complete developmental coursework should e-mail an Academic Advisor at nursing@ucc.edu.

3. The following co-requisite courses must be reflected on the applicants unofficial Union County College (UCC) transcript; as completed, transferred, currently enrolled, or registered for at UCC.

- a. Co-requisite courses are recommended to be taken before NURE 130, if possible.
 - BIO 105
 - ENG 101 or 112 (if ESL)
 - CHE 114
- b. A minimum grade of C is required in all Science courses and all courses transferred to UCC.

4. Establish a Union County College GPA of 2.5 or higher or high school GPA of 2.5* or higher

- a. A minimum Union County College GPA of 2.5 is required for admission.
 - The GPA must be established at Union County College *or*
 - *A high school GPA will be considered for applicants who graduated high school within a year of NURE 130 application submission.
- b. **The only exception to the 2.5 GPA requirement is for students who have transferred all NURE 130 co-requisite courses and have a Union County College GPA of zero (0).

5. Attendance at a Trinitas School of Nursing Information Session

- a. Attendance at a Trinitas School of Nursing Information Session is required prior to submitting your application. Attendance must be within 12 months of submitting application.
- b. Attach receipt of attendance, if attended after July 2019. This will be a paper receipt from July 2019 through March 2020, and an email receipt after February 2021.
- c. The current Information Session schedule and instructions on how to register can be found on the homepage of www.trinitasschoolofnursing.org.

6. You must obtain a minimum TEAS score of 55% prior to submitting your application

- a. All prospective students are responsible for reviewing and understanding the TEAS Assessment information located on the Trinitas School of Nursing website at <http://trinitasschoolofnursing.org/TSON-teas.htm>.

Application Submission Instructions for Trinitas School of Nursing

A complete application will include:

1. Current **Unofficial Union County College Transcript**
 - a. Must be printed from webservices with all required courses reflected.
 - b. This is the only college transcript that will be accepted.
 - c. All required courses that have been taken at another institution must be transferred in prior to applying and reflected on unofficial Union County College transcript.
2. TEAS Assessment Results
 - a. The TEAS transcript must be electronically transferred to Trinitas School of Nursing through ATI directly.
 - b. Please contact ATI directly regarding any questions regarding the transcript at 800.667.7531.
3. Official High School Transcript, if applicable
 - a. **Only applies** to applicants who meet the timeframe criteria for high school transcript evaluation.
4. Receipt from Trinitas School of Nursing Information Session, if attended after July 2019.
 - a. This will be a paper receipt from July 2019 through March 2020, and an email receipt after 2/2021.
